



Stansport Sleeping Bags...What you should know

Choose your bag from the category that best fit's your needs:

Promotional Bags

These lightweight summer bags are available in 3 lb single layer and 4 lb double layer constructions. They use high quality hollow fiber insulation, color consistent nylon shells, polyester linings, full length zippers, and come with their own nylon stuff sack. Temperature range is 40° degrees.

Deluxe Series

These bags all come with tuff nylon shells and soft cotton flannel linings. They offer warm double layer construction and come in 4 different temperature ranges. Each comes with its own nylon stuff sack. Temperature ranges are from 30° degrees to 10° degrees.

Premium Series

These oversized 39" x 90" hooded rectangle sleeping bags offer such features as double layer construction, and offset stitching. Full length draft tubes run along the zipper, around the collar, chest, and face. Complimented by two draw cords and cord locks, this integrated system eliminates cold drafts from entering the bag regardless of how much you turn in your sleep. The durable rip-stop nylon shells and soft cotton flannel linings insure a great night sleep. The 4 web and buckle compression bag is standard with all of the premium bags. Temperature ranges are from -5° degrees to -25° degrees.

Hunter Series

These oversized 39" x 84" rectangles are tuff bags! Made with premium heavy-duty 10.5 oz cotton duck shell fabric, and a soft cotton flannel lining, these bags have what it takes to keep you warm in the roughest of conditions. They feature double layer construction and off set stitching to eliminate cold spots even in the most extreme conditions. Temperature ranges are from -5° to -25° degrees.

Weather Shells

Space too limited to carry a tent? Expecting extreme weather conditions? Our Weather shell will keep you and your sleeping bag dry and warmer regardless of how much Mother Nature throws at you. Keeps wind, rain, dew, snow, and unwelcome insects off you and your sleeping bag. Adds at least 10° degrees additional comfort range to your existing sleeping bag. Accommodates bags up to 86" x 41". Available in forest green.
